Beginning at a point 30 feet W. of the W corner of the NE quarter of Section 14 S. and 19.95 chains N. of the NE corner of the D.L.R. of T. 5 S., R. 1 E., Yamhill County, Oregon, from which point an iron pipe 12 inches in diameter is run N. 29.34 degrees E. 1.57 chains to center of channel of the Willamette River 11' E. along center of channel of said river 1.37 chains to true corner of 4 S. 75 feet and W. 7 feet from true corner is a point on the NE corner of Block No. 26 in said town of Yamhill, Oregon, being the place of beginning and containing 23.26 acres.

T. Garrison D.L.C., Not. No. 1241, Claim No. 40, 8.09 chains from NE corner of said claim; thence N. 68° 30' W. along N. line of said claim 1.61 chains to the center of river; thence S. 41° 19' W. up the river 5.30 chains to the NE corner of County Survey No. 2007 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence S. 34.18 chains to place of beginning and containing 18.50 acres. The following restrictions and conditions:

The appropriation shall not exceed the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 5.375 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Yamhill River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion
not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation
season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state authority.

The priority date of this permit is February 17, 1954.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1954
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before the 1st day of August, 1954.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before the 1st day of September, 1954.
