

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Asel C. Koff, of 222 West Lincoln Avenue Salem, Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Neil Creek, a tributary of Miller, and reservoir, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2.0 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 980 ft. S. 41° 00' 18" W. from the corner of between Sections 2 and 3 in Township 9 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon

being within the N.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 9 S. R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Marion

5. The pipeline to be 2,000 ft. in length, terminating in the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 2, Tp. 9 S. R. 3 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 35 feet, length on top 398 feet, length at bottom 50 feet; material to be used and character of construction to be earth fill with wasteway around south end of dam

Also beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Sections 2 and 3 in Township 9 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian and running thence North $89^{\circ} 09'$ West 20.40 chains along the legal subdivision line running through the center of Section 3 to the Northwest corner of the William Neil Donation Land Claim; thence South 53.50 chains along the West line of the William Neil D.L.C. to the Southwest corner of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of said D.L.C.; thence South $88^{\circ} 38'$ East 26.80 chains along the South line of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the said William Neil D.L.C. to the Southwest corner of a 25.85-acre tract of land; thence North $25^{\circ} 45'$ East 9.18 chains to the Northwest corner of said 25.85-acre tract of land; thence North $88^{\circ} 38'$ West 26 links to the centerline of Pacific Highway; thence North 17° East 40.29 chains along the centerline of Pacific Highway; thence North $32^{\circ} 13'$ East 4.60 chains along the middle of the Pacific Highway; thence North $28^{\circ} 34'$ East 2.64 chains to the North line of the said William Neil D.L.C., said point being 13.73 chains North $88^{\circ} 15'$ West from the center of Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence North $88^{\circ} 15'$ West 25.95 chains along the North line of the William Neil D.L.C. to the point of beginning, containing 194.35 acres of land;

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following terms and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Nail Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-29302, Permit No. R-1639

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-1639,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 2, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1955 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1956

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957
