

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Charles Schibel, of Route 3, Box 187B, Portland 1, Oregon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed creek, a tributary of Cedar Mill Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.0275 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 700 ft. S and 1012 ft. E from the NW corner of Section 3

being within the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M., in the county of Washington

5. The pipe line to be approximately 200 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

A parcel of land lying in the J. Hall D. L. C. No. 58 (N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M., Washington County, Oregon, the said parcel being described as follows:

Beginning at a point 647 feet north and 1911 feet west of the southeast corner of the J. Hall D. L. C. No 58, said point also being 100 feet distant north-easterly from (when measured at right angles to) the center line of the Wolf Creek Highway; thence south 61 44' 30" east, parallel to and 100 feet from said center line, a distance of 685.8 feet to the center of the Barnes Road; thence north along the center line of said road a distance of 322.9 feet to a point; thence North 89 49' 30" west a distance of 604 feet to the place of beginning.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.018 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from SA. UNNAMED creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 6, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 21, 1956 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1956

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957
