

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Gerald Buck, of Route 2, Box 67-A, Jacksonville, Oregon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Applegate River, a tributary of Rogue River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.125 c.f.s. cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 2838 ft. S. and 1305 ft. E. from the corner of Section 19.

being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 40 S., R. 7 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson.

5. The pipeline to be 1100 feet in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 40 S., R. 7 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam.

(b) Description of headgate.

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 1.5" centrifugal pump by electric motor. Total lift 20 feet.

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 9, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 21, 1956 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1956

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957
