

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Central Oregon Irrigation District, Trustee, as Assignee of Don H. Peoples, Trustee of Redmond, County of Deschutes, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

(3) Pilot Butte Canal - N. 36° 45' W. 1056.8 ft. from Sec. cor. between S. 28 and 29, being within SE 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W.M. (4) Dam headgate - 1575' S. from NW corner, Sec. 16, T. 21 S., R. 8 E.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use 50,000 acre feet of stored water only and shall not exceed ~~1000 feet per second~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Crane Prairie Reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-13179, Permit No. R-1687

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to the duty of water as set out in the modified supplemental decree of the circuit court dated March 24, 1933 in the matter ~~of~~ of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of the Deschutes River and its tributaries; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further limited to the terms of the inter-district contract dated January 4, 1938, between the Central Oregon Irrigation District, Crook County Improvement District No. 1 and the Arnold Irrigation Company.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 28, 1913

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 21, 1956 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1956

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957

acre for lands covered by the Central Oregon Irrigation District and 7.30 acre
feet per acre for lands within the Crook County Improvement District No. 1, measured
at the point of diversion from the Deschutes River; provided that the amount of water
allowed herein together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the
same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further
limited to the terms of the interdistrict contract, dated January 4, 1938, between
the Central Oregon Irrigation District, Crook County Improvement District No. 1 and
the Arnold Irrigation District.
