## To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 30/100 (.30) cubic feet per second.

Remarks: **The spring arises on land of applicants and may not flow off of it. Applicants own a piece of land 50 feet by 50 feet in size on which is the spring, and they own the title in Fee to a right of way from their above 50 x 50 foot piece of land to the land on which the water is to be used.**

**"B" From the dam a trough made of wood and 25 feet long runs to a 2000 gallon wooden storage tank from which the pipe line runs.**

**The Water is to be used on rental units of applicants, being seventeen in number and for sale to some of the residents of the unincorporated village of Taylorville; it being expected that the water to be sold will be used in about 24 dwellings.**

**It is believed by applicants that technically no water right may be required as the water may not flow off their land, but they are filing for their own protection.**

**The water has been put to beneficial use as above provided since 1938, and the Diversion works, pipe line, dam and entire construction has been completed since 1941 and is now in use by applicants.**

**Of the water to be used the amount of .75 cubic feet per second would be for use in the rental units of applicants on the land described in Exhibit "A", and .75 cubic feet per second would be for sale to the other dwellings in Taylorville. These parties have hooked on to the end of pipeline of applicants.**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and garden per family.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 17, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1956 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1957.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1958.
