To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Morgan Creek, a tributary of Lookingglass Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/20th cubic feet per second all from one source

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 1703.46 ft. north and 361 ft. east from the SW corner of Robert Tate Donation Land claim No. 42 section 3 Township 8S Range 7 West Willamette Meridian. and 1773.46 feet north and 621 feet East of the South West corner of the Robert Tate Donation Land Claim No. 42 section 3 Township 28 South Range 7 West Willamette Meridian in Douglas County, Oregon.

being within the SW 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 28S, R. 7W, W. M., in the county of Douglas

5. The pipe line to be 720 feet in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 28S, R. 7W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same. **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Morgan Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/30 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 28, 1955

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1956 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed or or before October 1, 1957.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1958.
