

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. D. Adams of Box 252, Silveston, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream, a tributary of Santiam River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supply including lawn & garden

4. The point of diversion is located 12 ft. S and 435 ft. W from the corner of Sections 20929

being within the N.E. 1/4 S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 9S, R. 4E, W. M., in the county of Marion

5. The pipe line to be 700 ft. in length, terminating in the N.E. 1/4 S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 9S, R. 4E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate 2" steel pipe laid in creek

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description no pump - gravity flow

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is one family domestic including irrigation of 1/2 acre lawn and garden

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 15, 1956

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1957 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1957

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957
