To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

To John Larson, David Henry, Louella Harrison,
of Astoria, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Slide Creek, a tributary of Wilson River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 9/100 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic supplies, yard & sprinkling lawns

4. The point of diversion is located 1701.2 ft. N and 2178.7 ft. E from the SW corner of SE 1/4 of section 8, T. 1 S., R. 8 W., W.M.

being within the NW 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 1 S., R. 8 W., W. M., in the county of Tillamook

5. The Pipe line to be 1036.9 in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 1 S., R. 8 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying plan

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right hereto granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Slide Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for 6 families including irrigation of not to exceed 1/4 acre lawn and garden for each family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer

The priority date of this permit is September 12, 1956

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 20, 1957 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1958

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1958
