To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Roy M. Smith (Name of applicant)  
of Route 2, Ontario, Oregon (Mailing address)  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Snake River (Name of stream), a tributary of Columbia, River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 100 miners inches cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 25.5 ft. S 7° 25' E and ft. from the Govt. Witness corner located North 0.7 chains from the meander corner common to Sections 16 & 15 of T. 17 S., R. 47 E. W. 1. (Section or subdivision)  
(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary.)  
being within the Lot 4 (NE 1/4) of Sec. 15, Tp. 17 S., R. 47 E., W. M., in the county of Malheur.

5. The Main (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be approx. 1630' feet (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NW Corner of Lot 4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 17 S., R. 47 E. W. 1, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction.

(b) Description of headgate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of opening)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 10 HP Parma Water Lifter propeller type pump, maximum of 14 feet lift. (Size and type of pump)

\*\*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity with the exception of municipalities must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Snake River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same land shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 14, 1956.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 25, 1957 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1957.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957.
