

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Louisa M & Fred Tompkins of Box 257 Murphy Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Stream, a tributary of Williams Cr

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 796 ft. S and 100 ft. N from the NE corner of Box 257 Sec 2 E

being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 23 Tp. 36 N R. 12 W. M., in the county of 8

5. The Flume - 100 ft 2 1/2 inch pipe to be 1 1/2 in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 Sec 2 E of Sec. 23 Tp. 36 N R. 12 W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate Timber gate 12' 1/2'

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description D-1 Diesel Motor

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-31245, Permit No. R-1977.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be construction under Permit No. R-1977.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer

The priority date of this permit is August 1, 1956.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 25, 1958

the water be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1958

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1959
