

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. W. Strong (Name of applicant)

of Box 1051, Bandon (Mailing address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed stream (Name of stream) a tributary of Bear Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 20 gal. per min. cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Cranberry Bog Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located about 462 ft. S and 300 ft. W from the NE corner of Sec. 28, T 28 S., R. 14 W., W.M., in the stream bed approximately at the property line or below the existing point of diversion supplying the Haba Pipeline

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 28, Tp. 28 S, R. 14 W., W. M., in the county of Coos

5. The pipe line to be about 600 ft. in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 28, Tp. 28 S, R. 14 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 0.1 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 27, 1957

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1958 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 59.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 60.
