

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. T. S. Poole and Anna V. Poole, husband and wife, of Heekin, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Luckiamute River, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The points of diversion are located 1572.0 ft. and 203.3 ft. from the corner of Section 11, Tp. 10 S., R. 7 W.W.M. ... 1374.0 feet S. and 396.0 ft. W. from the NE. corner sec. 11, Tp. 10 S.R. 7 W.W.M. for the second point.

being within the SE/4 of Sec. 11, Tp. 10 S., R. 7 W.W.M., in the county of Benton

5. The pipe-line to be 1700 feet in length, terminating in the NE/4 of Sec. 11, Tp. 10 S., R. 7 W.W.M., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description Centrifugal Pump driven by either 10 h.p electric motor or 10 h.p gas motor Pump 4" with 25 spin lobes 300 gpm

\*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. \*\*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Luckiamute River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 12, 1957

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1958 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1959

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1960
