

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R E CHAPMAN, (Name of applicant)

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNN Stream and Reservoir, a tributary of Washink Lake.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.02 cubic feet per second. Spring Dam and Stream - Fish 0.01

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION - SMALL STORAGE POND FOR TRUCK WASHING

4. The point of diversion, is located 0 ft. S and 500 ft. E from the corner of SECS 15 & 22 in T14 R. 12 W. UNN Stream & Res - S68°E, 510 ft from spring (or - 0'S & 500'E thence S68°E 510')

Both being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 14 N, R. 12 W. M., in the county of WASHINGT.

5. The Main ditch, canal or pipe line to be 100 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 14 N, R. 12 W.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed spring, unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-31989, Permit No. R-2103

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for 1 family and fish culture, being 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for fish culture.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 22, 1957

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 27, 1959 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1959.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1960.
