PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed ~~4.2~~ acre feet stored water only measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Wasco Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-32043, permit No. R-2106

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of 4.2 acre feet of flow under feet per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 11, 1915

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 5, 1959 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1959

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1960
