APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Sam Macdonald (Name of applicant)  
of 5612 S.E. 45th Ave. Portland (Mailing address)  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tualatin River (Name of stream)  
a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Approx. 29  
gals. per minute

of the W.M.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Tualatin River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 6, 1958

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 17, 1959 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1960.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961
