

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. S. Smith (Name of applicant)

of No. 2, Box 171, Madras (Mailing address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Fedoa Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Lacklamute

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.18 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supply, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and 480 ft. E from the SW corner of NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 17 (Location or subdivision)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 17, Tp. 9 S (N. or S.)

5. The portable pump to be pipe line 300 ft. in length, terminating in the of Sec. 17, Tp. 9 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

R. 6 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (N. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 1 horse, 1 cycle Brigg & Stratton one pump, ten sprinklers at 80 gal. per. min. (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.
 **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 9.13 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Foodee Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 11, 1958

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 17, 1959 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1960.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961
