APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Alfred Johnson Lumber Company, by Robert Dollar Trustee (Name of Applicant)

of Prosper (Postoffice), County of Coos

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation. Date of incorporation February 17, 1913. Place, Coquille, Coos County, Oregon

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is McKee Gulch (Name of stream), tributary of Coquille River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is thirty-six hundredths cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is manufacturing and for the purpose of supplying the employees of applicant with water for domestic purposes (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 3080 feet east and 1175 feet south of the corner of section 16, 17, 19 and 20 of Township 28, South of Range 14 West of the Willamette Meridian

being within the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 20, Tp. 28 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 14 W, W. M., in the county of Coos (No. E. or W.)

5. The pipe line to be 2704.78 feet in length, terminating in the lot 5 of Sec. 17, Tp. 28 S, R. 14 W (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Alfred Johnson Lumber Company Pipe line

Applicant has concluded since making former application that the amount appropriated in former application would not be near sufficient to supply its boilers for steam purposes and its employees and prospective employees when the mills shall be running upon full time, with water.

This McKee Gulch contains considerable water in the winter time, but barely sufficient during the dry season.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The use of the water under this permit shall be limited to water for manufacturing purposes and for domestic use.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.36 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is August 5, 1915.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 11, 1916 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1917

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1918
