

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, A. E. Collings (Name of applicant)

of Route 2, Box 74, Jacksonville (Mailing address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Storage in Squaw Lake Reservoir, a trib. of Squaw Creek, a tributary of Big Applegate River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.13 c.f.s. cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 790 ft. N. and 1840 ft. E. from the W. corner of Section 6.

being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 6, Tp. 41 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The main ditch to be approximately 2 miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 36, Tp. 40 S., R. 4 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 1.5 feet, length on top 2.0 feet, length at bottom 10 feet; material to be used and character of construction Brush, loose rock, and dirt thrown across stream bed.

(b) Description of headgate 2.5 feet in height and 4.0 feet wide, constructed of logs.

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description gravity system.

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 15.0 acre feet stored water only ~~subject to measurement~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Squam Lake Reservoir as provided under application No. R-28239, permit No. R- 2205

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of 1/2 acre feet ~~subject to measurement~~ per acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 27, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 13, 1960 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1960

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961
