APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, North Unit Irrigation District, a municipal corporation of Madras, Oregon do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon. SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation an irrigation district organized under the laws of the State of Oregon on the 20th day of March, 1916.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Crooked River a tributary of Deschutes River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 200 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Supplemental Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 3350 ft. N and 2700 ft. E from the SW corner of Sec. 13, T. 14 S., R. 13 E.W.M.

being within the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 13 Tp. 14 S. R. 13 E. W. M. in the county of Deschutes

5. The pipe line to be 285 feet in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 13 Tp. 14 S. R. 13 E. W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same. SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 200.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Crooked River

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 23, 1955

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1962 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1960

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1960
