This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 acre feet of stored water only ~~subject to the amount~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Sester Reservoir #3 to be constructed under Application No. R-32587, Permit No. R-2214

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet ~~of base cubic feet per second~~ for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 26, 1959

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1960 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed or or before October 1, 1960.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961.
