

\*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Benton Timber Products Corporation of P. O. Box 506, Philomath, State of Oregon

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation February 1, 1955 Benton County, Oregon

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mary's River, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.34 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is log storage pond

4. The point of diversion is located 2120 ft. N and 2320 ft. W from the SE corner of W. Matzger D.L.C. #50 Section 11; T. 12 S; R. 6 W. W.M.

being within the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 11 Tp. 12 S R. 6 W., W. M., in the county of Benton

5. The Pipe Line to be 168 feet in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 11 Tp. 12 S R. 6 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description Stationary centrifugal 7-1/2 hp electric motor total head 15.5 estimated capacity of 150 gpm

\*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. \*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Mary's River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is maintenance of log pond to be constructed under application No. R-33119, permit No. R-2216

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 10, 1959

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1960 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1961

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1962
