

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jack B. Wolf (Name of applicant) of Box 958 Rainier (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Flewys into Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1343 ft. N and 894 ft. W from the S.E. corner of SW 1/4 of Section 23 T7N R2W. W.M. (Section or subdivision)

being within the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 23, Tp. 7 N, R. 2 W, W. M., in the county of Columbia

5. The Pipe line to be 140 feet in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of SW of Sec. 23, Tp. 7 N, R. 2 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 1, 1959

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 20, 1960 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1961

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1962
