



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Blanche Keesison of Stanfield, Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Spring Drainage ditch, a tributary of Drainage ditch

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1 1/2 cubic feet per second

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 30 ft. and 10 ft. from the corner of SE 1/4 S 1/4 Section 31 Tp. 4 N R. 29E

being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 31, Tp. 4, R. 29E, W. M., in the county of Umatilla

5. The Pump out Main Ditch to be No Permanent Pipe in length, terminating in the Shown Above of Sec. 31, Tp. 4, R. 29E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate Timber Sump

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 15 HP Centrifugal 3 Phase Electric Pump - Approx. 4 Ft. Lift

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed drainage ditch.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/10th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 28, 1960

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 18, 1961 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1961.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961.
