This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Jump Off Joe Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; the right allowed hereunder for the appropriation of water for lands having a valid prior right shall be limited to the amount necessary to make up any deficiency in water available to said lands under said prior right and the amount allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the said lands, shall be limited by the duty of water as fixed herein; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 22, 1960

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 13, 1961 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1961

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961
