

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. B. HARRYMAN (Name of applicant) of P. O. Box 57, Whistlers Park Estates, Roseburg (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and garden

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 7, 1960

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1961 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1962

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1963
