This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Lookingglass River

The use to which this water is to be applied is operation of a fishway.

The right allowed hereunder shall be subordinate and inferior to future appropriations of water for domestic, municipal, stockwater, commercial and industrial purposes.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 16, 1961

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 24, 1962 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1962
