

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Edward T. and Marie C. Goergen (Name of applicant)

of Rt. 3, Box 36, Lebanon (Mailing address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Beaver Creek (Name of stream)

a tributary of Crabtree Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .32625 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located N. 36. 75 Chains ft. and ft. from the SE corner of SW 1/4 of S. 35 (N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Section or subdivision)

(75 Chains due North)

in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 11S. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

R. 1W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 2" centrifugal pump powered by 7 1/2 H.P. electric motor. Will plan to use 30 five gallon sprinklers. (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Beaver Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 3, 1961

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1962 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1962

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1963
