

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Calvin P. Rose, of Star Route, Mohawk, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Parsons Creek, a tributary of Mohawk River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1875 cubic feet per second. Same amount (0.1875 cfs) alternately from 2 div. pts.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 1685 ft. N and 1310 ft. W from the W 1/4 corner of Sec 13, T16S, R2W, W.M.

being within the #1 - SW 1/4, NE 1/4, NE 1/4 #2 - SW 1/4, SW 1/4, NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 16S

R. 2W, W.M., in the county of Lane

5. The Main ditch (from Div. #1) to be 2600 ft in length, terminating in the NW 1/4, SW 1/4, NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 16S

R. 2W, W.M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works - Div. Pt. #1

6. (a) Height of dam 3 feet, length on top 24 feet, length at bottom 24 feet; material to be used and character of construction timber crib, rock filled bunker abutments, removable flaps bearings

(b) Description of headgate Timber, one opening 1' x 2'

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description Div. Pt. #2 4" Centrifugal 5 H.P. Electric or Gas 4' lift

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right hereto granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Parsons Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 80% of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 14, 1961

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 27, 1961 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1961

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961
