

\*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, P. H. RADFORD (Name of applicant) of R#6 Lakeview (Mailing address) State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is DRAW DITCH From Sec 13 34-4 (Name of stream) a tributary of Goose Lake

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 600 Ft. East from corner of THE West 1/4 Sec. 18 of Sec. 18 T. 39 S. R. 20 E. W. (N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Section or subdivision)

being within the NW SW of Sec. 18, Tp. 39 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) R. 20 E, W. M., in the county of Lake (E. or W.)

5. The Ditch (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 3/4 mile in length, terminating in the SW SE of Sec. 18, Tp. 39 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) R. 20 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

Remarks: The water for which I am making application is transported to my property by means of a drainage ditch which begins at approximately the center of Sec. 13. T39S. R19E.W.11 - Runs across property now owned by Mr. Elmer Gengel. Said ditch then runs in an East and then South direction across my property and eventually is intermingled with waters in what is known as the Leckmann Bishop ditch. This ditch drains some many lands in Sec. 13 - and collects mostly run off water from irrigation in said Sec. 13 - at a time when these lands are being irrigated - principally from Lakeview Water Users Inc. There is no definite point of collection in the ditch and collects a certain amount throughout its length. The same being true across portions of my property - which in turn is transported to users from the Leckmann Bishop ditch

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.98 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed drain ditch

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and the right allowed herein shall be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of waste water from lands which drain into the drainage ditch, and is subject to the terms and conditions of an order entered at pages 94 to 97, Volume 11, Special Order Record of the State Engineer, and by reference made a part hereof,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 4, 1960

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 8, 1962 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1963.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1964.
