

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Richard D. Chandler and Ann H. Chandler of Blue River, Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Elk Creek, a tributary of McKenzie River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supplies

4. The point of diversion is located 100 ft. S and 125 ft. E from the NW corner of Section 29, township 16 South Range 4 East of Willamette Meridian

being within the Northwest 1/4 of Northwest 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 16 S R. 4 E, W. M., in the county of Lane

5. The pipe line to be 200 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 16 S R. 4 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description Jet pump

1 hp electric motor

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Elk Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 4, 1961

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 26, 1962 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1963

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1964
