DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 3 feet 5 feet, length on top 5 feet, length at bottom

3 feet; material to be used and character of construction earth  
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate  
(Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description  
(Size and type of pump)

(Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

\*\*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the named tributary of stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from (Big Nestucca River)

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 21, 1961

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1962 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1963

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1964
