APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Charles E Rose (Name of Applicant)

of Williams (Postoffice), County of Josephine

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is East Fork of Williams Creek (Name of stream)

, tributary of Applegate River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located East bank of East Fork of Williams Creek, at a point bearing south 50 degrees East from the NW cor. Sec. 14 Tp. 39 S R 5 W. distant 49 chains (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 14, Tp. 39 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 5 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine (No. E. or W.)

5. The ditch to be 4 1/2 miles in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 38 S, R. 5 W (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DIVERSION WORKS—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The priority date of this permit is December 28, 1915

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1917

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1918

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1919
