\*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, U. S. Alderman (Name of applicant)

of Dayton (Mailing address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Yamhill River (Name of stream), a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.40 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

Remarks: Being a part of the Garney Goodrich D.L.C. Notification #1040 Claim #49 in Sections 16 and 21 in Tp. 4. S.R.3.W. of the Will. Mer. Oregon, and beginning at an iron pipe set for the Most Easterly N.E. corner of said Claim at point 165.0 feet West of the N.E. corner of said Section 21.  
 Thence West along Claim line and Section line, to iron pipe found in place for angle corner Claim. Thence N00°50'W set iron pipe in County road for most Northerly N.E. corner of Claim.  
 Thence West along Claim line at 527.8 feet set iron pipe for East line of 16.0 foot private road, set stake for West line of property.  
 Thence S00°27'W with line of old fence partly removed to anchor post, set an iron pipe 16.0 feet East and 16.0 feet S00°27'W for angle corner in said 16.0 foot road.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.40 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Yamhill River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 18, 1962

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 22, 1963 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1963

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1964
