This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same. SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Rogue River The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4% acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. at Raygold, more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.i.s. at its mouth, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
