APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, W. H. Raymond (Name of Applicant)

of Days Creek (Postoffice), County of Douglas

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Days Creek (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/8 cubic feet per second.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 13/100 (0.13) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 20, 1911
