APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, John Benson (Name of Applicant)

of Buncem, County of Jackson (Postoffice)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Star Gulch Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Applegate River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Three (3) cubic feet per second.

R. 3 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson (No. E. or W.)

5. The main ditch to be Two (2) miles in length, terminating in the N 1/2 of SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 39 S, R. 3 W (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is

Upper Cameron Ditch. (This is an old abandoned mining ditch, a permit to repair and use same has been granted to this applicant, by The Forest Service, U.S.A.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The right hereunder is expressly limited to water for mining purposes during the season from November 1st, to July 1st, of the next succeeding year.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is February 11, 1916

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 21, 1917 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1918

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1919
