This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed drainageway Whetstone and WHETSTONE BORROW RESERVOIR.

The use to which this water is to be applied is maintenance of Whetstone Borrow Reservoir to be constructed under application No. B-37595, permit No. 2989 and for wildlife propagation within the reservoir.

If for navigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

Provided further that the right to use of direct flow shall be limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. at Raygold, more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 30, 1962

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 5, 1963 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1964.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1965.
