

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, U. S. Forest Service, Mt. Hood National Forest, for the use and benefit of Snow Bunny Lodge

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

Diversion Works—

8. (a) Height of dam 22" feet, length on top 35" feet, length at bottom 60" feet; material to be used and character of construction concrete  
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

small cover house with gabled roof

(b) Description of headgate concrete; 1" pipe to pump, 2" overflow pipe  
(Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 2 1/2 H.P. gasoline Briggs & Stratton  
(Size and type of pump)

centrifugal - Water to be lifted about 15'. The water is held in a wooden

barrel type reservoir with a D-96" height of 6 1/2'. The reservoir is housed completely in a wood framed house with a concrete floor.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from two springs

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for a lodge including fire protection from the domestic system.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 8, 1963

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1964 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1966.
