

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ada R. Nelson (widow of Elmer R. Nelson, deceased)

of Route 1 Rockaway

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Nelson Spring a tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is

FIVE (5) GALLONS PER MINUTE

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic

4. The point of diversion is located 491.4 ft. North and 141.4 ft. West from the 1/4 Section corner of Sections 17 and 20

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Nelson Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 24, 1963

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 24, 1964 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1966.
