

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Wayne R. Triggell and Ernest R. Pugh of Summerville, Oregon do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is spring, a tributary of Lewis Branch

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. Domestic use each family. 0.01 cu ft. per second for stock

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and Stock about thirty (30) head of stock

4. The point of diversion is located 320 ft. S and 33 ft. E from the N.W. corner of N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 10, Township on (1) S Range Thirty Eight (38) East Willamette Meridian

Section line 1/4 W. R.P.P.I. plus 41.79

being within the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 10, Tp. 1 S, R. 38 E, W. M., in the county of Union

5. The 1 1/4" Pipe line to be 627 feet in length, terminating in the E 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 10, Tp. 1 S, R. 38 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

(a) Height of dam Six (6) feet, length on top 3' x 3' I.D. feet, length at bottom same feet; material to be used and character of construction Concrete 6" walls

(b) Description of headgate None 1 1/4" Pipe to house

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description Gravity flow to house. Pressure pumps in the house

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of two families, including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and garden and stock uses being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 8, 1963

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 18, 1964 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1966.
