

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

1. Clarence W. Redenius (Name of applicant) of Route 4 Box 759, Roseburg (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Not a corporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Lookingglass Creek (CLALLA) (Name of stream), a tributary of South Umpqua

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25 cfs cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Supplies - Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 717 ft. S and 320 ft. E from the NW corner of Lake Fremont P.L.C. No. 49 (N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 28 S. (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

5. The Pipeline to be 200 (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 28 S. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

R. 7 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

That portion of the John Freeman D.L.C. No. 49, T. 28 S. R. 7W, W. 1, Douglas County, Oregon, which is described as follows: BEGINNING at a three quarter inch iron pipe at the NW corner of said D.L.C., to a point on the N. line of the county road which runs from Highway 42 Northerly to Lookingglass, from which a one inch aluminum pipe bears E. 35.8 ft, thence running along the Northerly line of said County Road, S53° E. 211.7 ft., S70° W 278.7 ft & S. 73° W. 159.2 ft to a point which is opposite the North end of a concrete road culvert, thence running S21° E across said County road and along the center of a ditch from said culvert a distance of 255.0 ft., thence S49°-43' W 214.2 ft, and S57° W 553.97 ft to a point on the W. line of said D.L.C., thence running N 947.53 ft. along W. line of said D.L.C. to the place of beginning containing 11.4 acres,

more or less, excepting the county road.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Lookingglass Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 7, 1963

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 9, 1964 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1966.
