APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, James W. Dessert

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is East Fork Evans Creek, tributary

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from East Fork Evans Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/900 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 16, 1964

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 1, 1965 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1966

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1967
