

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mrs. Lee Eyerly (Name of applicant) of 4940 Sunnyside Road, S. E., Salem (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS;

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Metolious River (Name of stream), a tributary of Deschutes River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and lawn irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located #1 - 275' N 240' E 2 - 190 ft. N and 150 ft. E from the SW corner of Lot 1, Sec. 18, T. 11 S., R. 11 E., W. M. (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 of Sec. 18, Tp. 11 S. (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Metolius River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of three families including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and garden at each residence.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 8, 1964

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 8, 1966 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1966

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1967
