## APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

## To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Robert S. Griffin  
(Name of applicant)  
of Route 2, Box 586, Central Point,  
(Mailing address)  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rogue River  
(Name of stream)  
a tributary of Pacific Ocean  
2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.21 c.f.s.  
cubic feet per second.  
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation  
(Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1390 ft. N. and 1910 ft. E. from the SW  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)  
corner of Section 29  
(Section or subdivision)

being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 35 S.

R. 1 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.  
(E. or W.)

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

## Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam                      feet, length on top                      feet, length at bottom                      feet; material to be used and character of construction                       
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate                       
(Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 2" x 3" centrifugal direct drive  
(Size and type of pump)  
10 H.P. 3 phase electric motor.  
(Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)  
Total head + 35 feet.

\*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

\*\*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Rogue River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 23, 1964

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 18, 1966 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 66.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 67
