APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Maxine E. Hewitt (Name of applicant) of Route 2, Box 257, Dallas, Polk County, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is two springs flowing into Lauderdale Creek, a tributary of Rickreall Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 5 gal. per second. 5 gal. from No. 1 spring; 1/2 gal. from No. 2 spring.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supply, stock water, and irrigation.

4. The point of diversion is located 29.56 chains from the corner of sec 36, T7S, R2W, W.M. and 100 ft. from the intersection of Oakdale Road (Co. road, 667) and Glendale-Oakdale Cutoff (Co. road, 7512)

No. 2 spring-point of diversion is located 27.5 ft. from the same above mentioned intersection.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.011 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from two springs

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and stock; being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic from East spring and 0.005 c.f.s. from east spring and 0.001 c.f.s. from west spring for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 14, 1964

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 12, 1966 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1966.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1967.
