

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Harold Monroe David Kraemer of RT 1 Box 10 MT. ANGEL State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation NONE

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is ZOLLNER CREEK, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.98 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION

4. The point of diversion is located #1 80 ft S and 860 ft W from the NE corner of SECTION 3 T6S R1W W.M. BEING WITHIN THE NE 1/4 OF THE NE 1/4 OF SECTION 3 T6S R1W W.M.

THE POINT OF DIVERSION FOR #2 IS LOCATED 380' S AND 470' W FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 3 T6S R1W W.M.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.98 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Zollner Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 1, 1965

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 24, 1966 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1967

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1968
