CERTIFICATE NO. ON DIVERSION

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Harry J. Walsh (Name of applicant) of Route 2, Box 362, Gold Hill, Oregon (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Spring, tributary of Unnamed Gulch, a tributary of Rogue River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.03 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic and irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 750 ft. S. and 600 ft. W. from the E/4 corner of Section 16

being within the NE/4 SE/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 36 S. R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson.

5. The pipeline to be 620 feet in length, terminating in the NE/4 SE/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 36 S. R. 3 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic use of two families, being 0.025 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 8, 1965

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 25, 1967 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1968.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1969.
