

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Lester Hall (Name of applicant) of Yachats (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is The Yachats River (Name of stream), a tributary of The Pacific Ocean.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.31 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 289 ft. S (N. or S.) and 1553 ft. E (E. or W.) from the SW corner of Sec. 33, T14S, R11WWM (Section or subdivision) and the second point of diversion is located 68 ft S and 2342 ft E from the SW Corner of Sec. 33, T14S, R11WWM. These described points are electric power poles where the power is to be taken off for the electric pump. (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

Both points of diversion (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 (Give smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 4, Tp. 15S (N. or S.), R. 11W (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of Lincoln.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Yachats River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 18, 1965

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 19, 1967 and shall

hereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1968.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1969.
