The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Sutton Creek The use to which this water is to be applied is ____irrigation and supplemental irrigation second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a ____diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated____ during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the rightallowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply..... of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 27, 1967 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19...68...
